## Une entrevue avec un/e camarade de classe

Your partner is going to be in the local newspaper in the community member of the week spotlight section. You are going to conduct the interview and write the article.

1. Create your questions. What do you want to know about your partner? What might other newspaper readers want to know about your partner? What are their accomplishments, hobbies, etc.?
2. Meet with your partner and ask your questions. Listen carefully to your partner and write down their responses. You do not need to write down everything they say verbatim-- just jot down key words and phrases to help you remember what they said. Ask clarifying and/or follow up questions as needed. Also, sketch out a drawing of your partner to include with your article.
3. Now your partner will interview you. Answer their questions as best you can and give as much information as you feel comfortable giving.
4. After the interview, use the information you wrote down during the interview to write a short biography article about your partner for the newspaper community member spotlight. Include their full name and at least 5 other interesting facts about them. Also include a hand-drawn picture of your partner.
5. You will share your rough draft of your article with your partner and the class. Be sure to share your picture as well! ()
