Then, respond to the post by answering the questions below.

2. How well did your peer include important information? Was this information detailed and descriptive enough? Please support your answers with specific examples.
3. Did your peer include all of the information that you would need in order to plan to attend the festival? What would you have liked more detail on? What, if any, additional information should have been included?
4. How well did your peer draw your attention to important details? Support your answer with specific details from your peer’s work. You may need to listen to the video again.
5. Using the rubric for this assessment from the **assessment folder**, what score would you give your classmate and why? Justify your score with specific evidence from the work.
