Remember that two heads are better than one!

Ask why or how questions (Why do you think you're having trouble persuading in Spanish?, How could you work on making your summaries clearer and easier to understand?, etc.) not just who, what, when, where.

Ask your teacher for clarification. If you are almost at a solution, but need a little extra help, your teacher is there for you.

If you're a higher level than your tutee, you can use your skills and knowledge to help them with problems they might have. This also means you grow as a class and have more people to practice with at a higher level!

If you're at a lower level than your tutee, it's OK. There are plenty of things you can still help them with. Remember, the best way to know you've mastered something is if you can teach it to others!
