A. Type of Project: Report Poster Presentation

B. Content of your poster: A description of your current event with five predictions of how the event will impact the future.

Step 1: Choose information from the infographics you filled in in **Inquiry Instructions Handout** to address following questions:

- Who is your audience?
- Why does your audience need to know about your current event?

- What is the event about?

- Who are involved in the event? What are their roles?

- When and Where does it take place? Does the time or the location matter?

- Why does this event attract your attention? OR How might this event attract your audience's attention?

- What is your prediction for the impact of your current event to the future?

- What do you learn from the event that you were not aware of before?
