

These example English conversations are included as examples for educators. Educators should create their own conversations (or find examples) in the L2.

Conversation 1

John: Well, it's really getting late.

Alice: You are welcome to stay as long as you like! John: Thanks, Alice. But I really need to get going.

Alice: Okay...if you're sure [Hugs John and walks with him to the driveway]

John: Before I go, what are you doing next weekend? My friend and I are going to the

John: Better get the coats out. [Buckles seat belt]. Bye, Alice.

Alice: Bye, John.

Conversation 2

Montez: Well, it's getting really late.

Alicia: You're right. I should probably get going.

Montez: Thanks so much for coming over. I had a great time.

Alicia: Me too! And thanks for the delicious dinner!

Montez: Anytime. Bye, Alicia.

Alicia: Bye, Montez.

Conversation 3

Isla: [Leaves party without saying goodbye at all]

Partygoers: [Plan to leave the same way, for the most part]
